## From Sydney airport

We have negotiated a special discounted price of \$8 one way and \$14 return with Kingsford Smith Transport Shuttle Service for "Drama Australia National Conference" delegates. To be eligible for these discounted rates simply advise this office of your interest and the appropriate form will be emailed to you for your completion and return direct to the service provider. Provided you let them know you are coming they will meet and greet you and direct you to their location at the airport and transfer you to your hotel. Ask for a booking form from your secretariat

**From Coogee** the #370 bus departs from Arden St every 30 minutes (10 min trip) and takes you to High St – a short 5 min walk to NIDA.

**From Randwick** the #400 bus departs from High St near the hospital every 10-15 minutes (5 min trip). Phone State Transit Info line 131500 or look on their website for maps and timetables [www.13100.com.au](http://www.13100.com.au)

## From City Central

To the east of the city of Sydney, buses run regularly from Circular Quay (Stand E), along Elizabeth Street, Oxford Street and then onto Anzac Parade. It takes approximately 30 minutes to travel from Circular Quay to NIDA. Alight at the main entrance to UNSW and cross Anzac Parade at the pedestrian lights.

Bus routes include the:

392, 394, L94, 396, 397 and 399

There is also a university bus during university terms, **the 890** which turns just before NIDA onto High Street, if catching this bus you will need to alight at the first stop after it turns, walk back towards Anzac Parade and cross at the traffic lights at the corner of Anzac Parade and High Street.

## From Central Station

To the east of the city of Sydney, buses run regularly from Central (Stand C) in Eddy Avenue. It takes approximately 30 minutes to travel from Central to NIDA. Alight at the main entrance to UNSW and cross Anzac Parade at the pedestrian lights.

Bus routes include the:

391, 393 and 395

There is also a university bus during university terms, the 891 (or 895 express) which turns just before NIDA onto High Street, if catching this bus you will need to alight at the first stop after it turns, walk back towards Anzac Parade and cross at the traffic lights at the corner of Anzac Parade and High Street.
