

HOW TO GET TO ST ALOYSIUS (The Official Welcome)



From Coogee

Take the # 372 or # 374 bus to Central Station. OR catch the 3:35pm # 373 bus to Circular Quay, walk west to Circular Quay West and catch the Matilda Ferry (see below)

From Anzac Parade, Kensington (NIDA)

Take the # 391, # 392, # 393 or L94 bus to Central Station. OR catch the 3:20pm # 392 or 3:45pm # L94 bus to Circular Quay, walk west to Circular Quay West and catch the Matilda Ferry (see below)

From City Central Station

Catch the North Shore and Western Line north to Milson's Point (3 stops).

From Milson's Point Station

From the station turnstile turn left and walk out to Ennis St. Turn right and walk down to first traffic light at Broughton St. Walk down Broughton St past the second traffic light to Pitt St. Turn left into Pitt St and then right in Jeffrey St.

From West Circular Quay (The Rocks)

The Matilda Ferry leaves West Circular Quay in front of the Museum of Contemporary Art at 4:26pm for the Jeffrey St wharf. From the wharf walk up Jeffrey St till you reach the college and the garage doors.

From Airport

The Kingsford Smith Airporter will have a bus departing the airport at 4.00pm to take interstate travellers to the Official Welcome at St Aloysius – This bus MUST be prebooked with Kingsford Smith Airporter – call your conference secretariat for a booking form or email Luba.Richards@conferenceplus.com.au or download a copy off the conference website www.conferenceplus.com.au/drama06

By cab

You will need to ask your driver to let you off outside # 20 Jeffrey St., Kirribilli. **Call 133 300**

By car

Because the college has a major function on at the same time and because parking around Kirribilli is very tight the college is asking you not to come by car.

Entrance to the rooftop terrace at St Aloysius College is via the lower section of Jeffrey St. The door is between two large garage roller doors opposite # 20 Jeffreys St - in between Pitt St (off Broughton St) and Kirribilli Ave.
