Day 3: Join TassieLink. Travel to World Heritage Wilderness at Cradle Mountain National Park. On your arrival there's a welcome platter of cheese and fruit. Overnight: Cradle Mountain Lodge (Pencil Pine Cabin).

Day 4: Choose an activity available from Cradle Mountain Lodge (own cost) or try a short walk. Overnight: Cradle Mountain Lodge.

Day 5: Depart for Launceston with TassieLink (transfer to Hobart available at extra cost).
